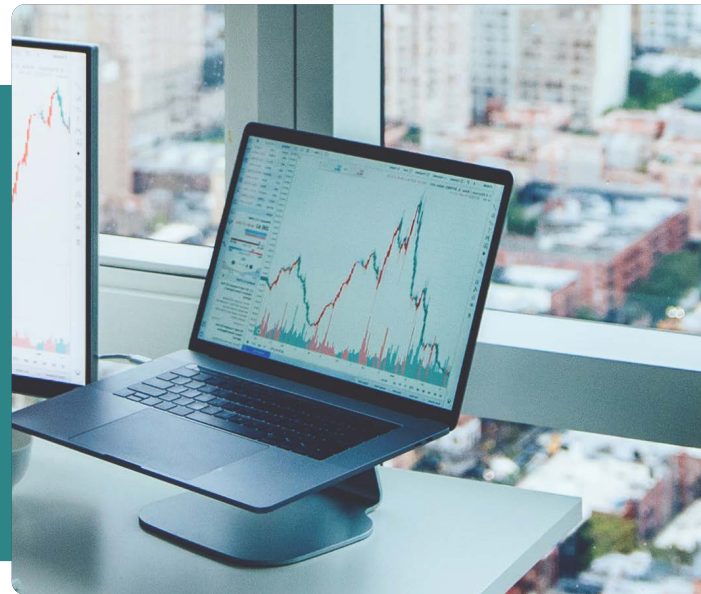

Cases and Engagements

In Re Credit Default Swaps Auctions Litigation

In 2022, investors filed an Amended Complaint (1:21-cv-00606) alleging that Defendant banks conspired to manipulate benchmark prices for settling Credit Default Swaps (CDS). Econ One's Dr. Jeff Armstrong provided statistical and econometric evidence of collusion and price impacts. The court denied the banks' motion to dismiss, citing the Plaintiffs' statistical allegations as a plausible antitrust conspiracy.

Merced Irrigation District v. Barclays Bank PLC

In 2016, Merced Irrigation District filed a class action against Barclays Bank PLC, alleging violations of the Sherman Act through a scheme to monopolize electricity markets. Econ One's Dr. Jeffrey Leitzinger was retained to measure the impact of Barclays' alleged market manipulation, calculate resulting overcharges, and assess harm to market participants. Dr. Leitzinger submitted an expert report and provided deposition testimony. The case settled in 2018 for \$29 million.

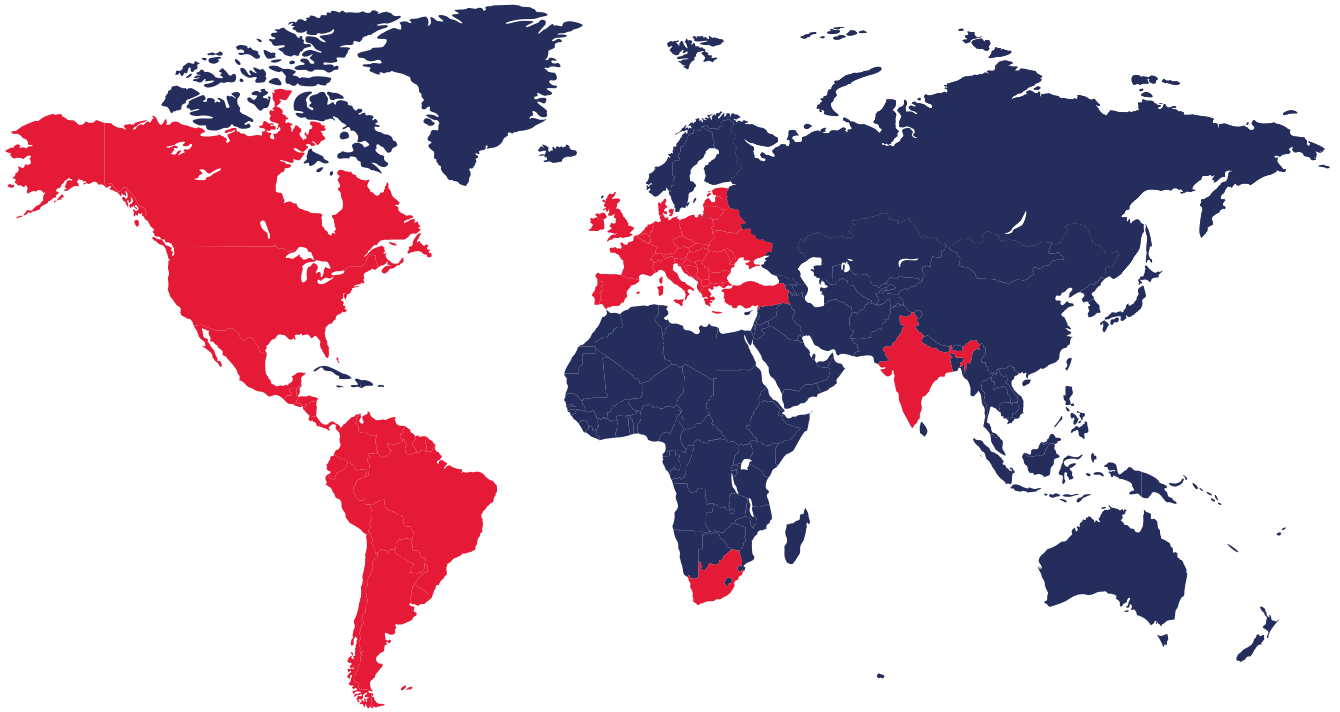
